What is a Willamette Sponsored Program?

All the programs listed below are Willamette Sponsored Programs. Willamette programs are facilitated by Willamette University, a third-party provider, a consortium to which Willamette belongs, or in conjunction with other universities as part of bilateral exchanges agreements. Programs may be identified as Salem-based or PNCA programs and some programs allow for students from either campus to participate.

Semester and Year Program Costs

You may use your Willamette, federal, state and local financial aid for WU program costs. Costs are distributed as follows:

- **Tuition:** Your WU student account will be billed WU tuition.
- **Housing and Meals:** See the columns titled “Cost Billed to Your WU Student Account”, “Housing” and “Meals” for more information. Students pay the cost of housing and meals to one of the following: a) pay Willamette and then receive housing and meals abroad, b) pay the host university or program directly, c) to a private landlord or purchase and prepare own food, or d) a combination (such as pay room to Willamette and pay for food abroad).
- **Additional costs are very important to consider!** Additional costs may include, but are not limited to:
 - passport - renewal or new
 - airfare and travel to/from the program site
 - visa and/or residency permit costs (when applicable) - this may include application fees and postage
 - domestic travel to apply for visa (when applicable)
 - additional health insurance, depending on individual program structure and individual student needs
 - travel insurance (optional)
 - local transportation (when applicable)
 - Generally, students spend more out-of-pocket money while abroad than during a typical semester at Willamette. These costs are usually associated with extra leisure travel, cost-of-living differences, eating out, entertainment, and purchasing gifts and souvenirs. Summer Program Costs - Summer study abroad program costs are treated differently than semester and year-long programs. Each program has a set program fee based on actual costs associated with the program (this may include items such as tuition, room/board, local transportation, excursions and insurance). The cost for each program is determined each year based on the current rates for services and number of participants in that program. Health Insurance Information: WU REQUIREMENT: ALL students must have health insurance that covers them at their off-campus program location. PROGRAM OR HOST COUNTRY REQUIREMENT: Some programs or host countries require *specific* insurance while others do not. See the column titled “Insurance Information”.
